Happy 2022

Because it is the first of the year, it's a good idea to go over some rules we have for attending community integration activities and requesting services. Our agency offers transportation as most of you. Your buy in for receiving transportation is calling in advance and scheduling with me for your transportation needs. For example, if you want to go shopping you need to call prior to the first shopping day of the month AND prior to the second day of shopping in a month. If you need transportation for a doctor/medical reason sometimes it's a good idea to call me and get some days in advance before you schedule the appointment. But, if you have an appointment scheduled, call me as soon as you can to see if I can transport you.

From time to time things come up and I will not be able to transport you. I encourage you to have a backup in place that you can use to get where you need to go. I am thinking about scheduling an exercise class, not a high impact class, a couple of days each week. If you are interested in attending please, please call me and let me know you would like to come. We would be doing the class in the larger room in the senior center a couple of days each week, probably Tuesday and Thursday.
