3 Strike System.

After 3 strikes, you will not be eligible to receive transportation from us for 3 months (starting from the last strikes)

Example of Strikes:

- You don't cancel transportation BEFORE the driver calls or they're already picking up people.
- Driver waits outside your home or location for more than 5 minutes.
- You don't clean up after yourself.
- Disruptive behavior in the van.
- Refusal to listen to the driver.
- Other forms of misconduct.



Ability 1st Utah moved to a new location September 2020. We looked for many years to find our own building and we now have a building that will give us the room to expand, so that more consumers can be served and benefit from our services. Our accessibility project will include the installation of an ADA Complaint Elevator, new Lobby, and a new ADA accessible ramp on

the west side of our building, as well as an ADA accessible bathroom. Ability 1st Utah has been raising funds for our accessibility project since we moved in. As of March 2023 we have raised a total of \$425,848 in funds. We hope to begin our project soon, and we will keep you updated on our accessibility project, in future newsletters. 




